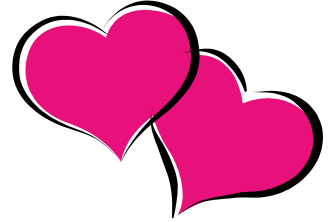




Won't you be my Valentine, Neighbor,
