

## **WHO NEEDS A SOLICITOR'S PERMIT?**

From the city website: Peddler/Solicitation Permit

Any person, who desires to engage in the business of peddling or soliciting and is going from house-to-house, or place-to-place, within the legal boundaries of the City of Costa Mesa, must first obtain a permit from the Costa Mesa Police Department. Peddling or soliciting includes any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of going house-to-house, or place-to-place, other than commercial business houses, or at, on, or along the public streets, sidewalks or public places, selling or taking orders for, or offering to sell or take orders for goods or services to be performed in the future, or for things of value to be delivered in the future, or performing services which require further development, consummation or completion elsewhere than at the place where performed. Exception: persons who solicit for non-profit organizations must obtain a permit from City Hall Finance Department.
