- 1.) Social Security 800-772-1213 (open 7am-7pm M-F)
SSI is a Federally funded program that give monthly benefits to people who are 65 and over, blind or disabled. Social Security decides who is eligible, this includes a physical or mental condition that keeps them from working.
- 2.) Reduced fee ID card \$6.00 is obtained by using DMV form: DL 937
Must meet eligibility: a client receiving services through CalWorks, GR, Cal Fresh, CFAP (not Medical) A Human Services Specialist Supervisor (HSSS) or Social Work Supervisor (SWS) will process this form DMV 800-777-0133 (8am-5pm M-F)
- 3.) CalFresh (food stamps) 877-847-3663
This program issues monthly benefits that can be used to buy most foods at many markets and food stores.
